GARAGE SALES

§ 10-7-2 GARAGE SALES LIMITED.

A person shall not be permitted to conduct more than three garage sales a year, nor to participate in more than five multi-home garage sales per year without being required to procure a second hand dealer's license.

GARAGE SALE SIGN. A temporary sign used to advertise the sale of second-hand merchandise from the garage or driveway of a residence.

§ 6-11-16 SIGNS IN THE RESIDENTIAL ZONES (R-1, R-2, R-3, R-4).

(6) **Garage sale signs.** Garage sale directional signs not exceeding six square feet in surface area per face and not exceeding four feet in overall height may be placed within the public right-of-way under the following conditions:

(a) Signs may be in place on Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays only between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.

(b) Signs must be free standing, not attached to any utility pole or structure nor any traffic control sign.

(c) No attention attracting devices such as pennants, streamers, balloons, inflatable shapes, banners, flashing lights or other illumination shall be attached to a garage sale sign or placed in the public right-of-way.

(d) A maximum of four signs for each garage sale may be placed in the public right-of-way.

(e) No sign greater than 30 inches in height shall be placed within any portion of the 25 foot sight triangle as extended to the street pavement on the triangles third (non right-of-way) side. The triangle is made up of the area of 25 feet from the point of intersection of two street right-of-way lines forming a corner.

(f) No more than one sign directing the public in any one direction shall be placed at any intersection. EXCEPTION: No sign may be placed on the four corners at Gary Avenue and Lies Road.

(g) Signs found to be in violation of the regulations will be removed and stored in the dumpster area at the Village Hall prior to disposal.

(7) **Community message boards.** Permitted for public institutions, on public property of more than one acre of land, not exceeding 96 square feet in area or eight feet in height. (Am. Ord. 92-06-75, passed 6-23-92; Am. Ord. 93-01-15, passed 1-26-93; Am. Ord. 93-04-42, passed 4-13-93)
