Note: Political Signs may be placed on private property or within the public right-of-way. A permit is not required for the placement of a political sign.

Political Signs Placed On Private Property

- When placed on private property, political signs must be no larger than 32 square feet in area, and no greater than six feet in height.
- Political signs must not be placed on private property without first obtaining the consent of the property owner.

Political Signs Placed Within The Public Right-Of-Way

- Generally, private signs are not permitted to be placed within the public right-of-way. However, political signs may be placed within the public right-of-way on a temporary basis. The signs may remain for a maximum of 45 days, and must be removed upon the close of the event or election.
- Political signs placed within the public right-of-way must be no larger than eight square feet in area, and must not be located too near a street intersection, so that the sign does not interfere with the line-of-sight of motorists (25-foot “sight triangle”).
- Persons wishing to place political signs within the public right-of-way are advised to first obtain the consent of the adjacent property owner.

NOTE: SIGNS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE PLACED ON ANY UTILITY POLES, TRAFFIC SIGNAL STANDARDS OR ANY UTILITY/TRAFFIC CONTROL BOXES.
