

# *Village of Carol Stream*

## INTERIM SMOKING SHELTER REGULATIONS

---

The regulations contained herein are based on the current regulations for temporary tent structures and permanent accessory structures in the Village of Carol Stream, and the requirements of the Smoke Free Illinois Act. Please note that an evaluation of the Village's regulations for temporary and permanent smoking shelters is in process, and new regulations will be reviewed at a future public hearing before the Plan Commission and then brought to the Village Board. ### **Temporary Smoking Shelters must:**

1. Comply with all requirements of the Carol Stream Fire Code.
2. Be placed for a duration of no more than 180 days. (Building Code Section 3103.1)
3. Be located a minimum of 15 feet away from any entry door, operable window, outdoor eating area or ventilation intake that serves an area where smoking is prohibited.
4. Not be located between the primary building and an adjacent street.
5. Be anchored in such a manner as to prohibit them from becoming a hazard in severe weather conditions.
6. Not be larger than 12 feet on any side.
7. Only be enclosed on three sides or fewer. The fourth side must remain open at all times.
8. Not provide food or beverage service, nor allow such consumption within the shelter.
9. Not include heating or cooking devices. (Fire Code Section 2404.7)

### **Permanent Smoking Shelters must:**

1. Comply with all requirements of the Carol Stream Building and Zoning Codes. (See Zoning Code Section 16-12-1.) A building permit is required.
2. Be located a minimum of 15 feet away from any entry door, operable window, outdoor eating area or ventilation intake that serves an area where smoking is prohibited.
3. Not be located between the primary building and an adjacent street.
4. Be anchored in such a manner as to prohibit them from becoming a hazard in severe weather conditions.
5. Only be enclosed on three sides or fewer. The fourth side shall remain open at all times.
6. Not provide food or beverage service, nor allow such consumption within the shelter.
