Carol Stream police have charged a 35-year-old Carol Stream man Saturday afternoon with the murder of his mother that occurred yesterday afternoon at their apartment.

Robert R. Lyons, of 222B Klein Creek Ct., Carol Stream was charged with one count of first degree murder and will be transported to DuPage County Jail pending a bond hearing on Sunday morning at 8 a.m. The bond hearing will be in courtroom 1000 at 501 N. County Farm Road, Wheaton

A post-mortem autopsy was conducted by the DuPage County Coroner's Office Saturday morning.

Police were called to the Klein Creek apartment at 3:17 p.m. in regards to a possible domestic at that location and a request to check on the well being of the residents.

Upon arrival, police found the apartment unsecure and Linda R. Bolek, 61, of 222B Klein Creek Ct. lying on the floor in the kitchen. Bolek had suffered multiple stab wounds.

Carol Stream police apprehended Lyons at the Hooter's Restaurant, 1705 E. Golf Rd. in Schaumburg at 8:53 p.m. Schaumburg police had found the vehicle Lyons was apparently driving parked in the Woodfield Mall parking lot. Detectives then began searching the local businesses when Lyons was discovered at the restaurant.

The DuPage County State's Attorneys' Office assisted with the investigation and approved the charge.

All subjects arrested are presumed innocent until found guilty in a court of law.
