Speeding motorists beware...

The Carol Stream Police Department, with funding from the **Illinois Department of Transportation Division of Traffic Safety**, is launching a month-long crack down on motorists who speed on North Avenue. A recently awarded Speed Enforcement Grant will fund speed enforcement initiatives along IL Route 64 (North Ave.) between Schmale and Kuhn Roads. Police will be conducting high profile, zero tolerance enforcement for speeding violators.

As a part of this effort, the Carol Stream Police will be sending motorists a strong message...if you speed in Carol Stream, you will be ticketed. Along with their citation, violators will receive an informational card provided by **Faces 4** (faces4.org), a community group founded by family members of victims killed in speed-related crashes. This informational campaign is a community partnership between Faces 4 and the Illinois Department of Transportation.

For the Month of March, officers will intensify enforcement of speed restrictions along Route 64. The speed limit is 45 miles per hour. If you are caught speeding, you will be ticketed. No exceptions, no excuses.

"We participate in the high visibility enforcement because it works," said Traffic Sergeant John Jungers. With the cooperation of the public, we will reduce the average speed, reduce crashes and save lives. I hope that all motorists **obey the speed limit and arrive alive.**"
