The Carol Stream Police Department as part of the statewide "***Click It or Ticket Mobilization***", conducted a two-week enforcement campaign from November 16<sup>th</sup> to December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Funding for this campaign was provided by the **Illinois Department of Transportation Division of Traffic Safety**.

Officers conducted high visibility enforcement zones throughout the village day and night, rain or shine. Carol Stream Police Traffic Sgt. John Jungers said, "Although the safety belt usage rate is 90 percent in Illinois, we will continue doing this type of enforcement until every motorist buckles up every time".

During this two-week period, 227 motorists were cited for not wearing a properly adjusted safety belt. In addition 16 motorists were cited for child safety seat violations.

The enforcement campaign also netted 15 drivers not having a valid driver's license and one DUI arrest.

The "***Click It or Ticket Mobilization***" is coordinated by the Illinois Department of Transportation, with support from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and law enforcement nationwide.
