The Carol Stream Police Department has achieved third place in the 2008 Illinois Traffic Safety Challenge. The award recognizes the Department's excellence in traffic safety. "I'm very proud of the Department's efforts in traffic safety. This award helps validate what we are trying to accomplish in our traffic safety efforts," Chief Kevin Orr said. The Department will receive the award at an awards ceremony on August 12th.

The Traffic Safety Challenge is a statewide highway safety program that recognizes law enforcement agencies for their efforts in addressing traffic and highway safety issues in their jurisdiction. The program is coordinated by the Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police Traffic Committee and is funded by a grant from the Illinois Department of Transportation – Division of Traffic Safety. Participation in the program is voluntary and requires agencies to submit a detailed report of their policies, officer training, public information and education initiatives and effectiveness measures.
