ACCOLADE ELM



Height at maturity:	60'
Spread:	40'
Description:	Tall hybrid elm with upright spreading habit, large shiny leaves and good fall color (gold).

ARISTOCRAT PEAR

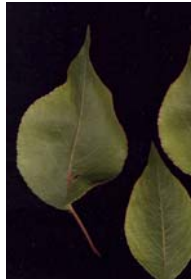
(*Pyrus calleryana* 'Aristocrat')



Height at maturity:	25'-40'
Spread:	20'-30'
Description:	Dark green glossy foliage with deep red fall color; white flowers in March; smooth light gray bark.

AUTUMN BLAZE PEAR

(*Pyrus calleryana* 'Autumn Blaze')



Height at maturity:	25'-45'
Spread:	25'-35'
Description:	White flowers in the spring, glossy foliage, red fall color

GREENSPIRE LINDEN

(*Tilia cordata* 'Greenspire')



Height at maturity:	40'-60'
Spread:	35-50'
Description:	Dense pyramidal to oval crown, blooms in late June, turns yellow in the fall.

HACKBERRY (*Celtis occidentalis*)



Height at maturity:	40'-70'
Spread:	50'
Description:	Large spreading crown with arching branches; light green summer foliage turns yellow in the fall.

KENTUCKY COFFEE TREE (*Gymnocladus dioica*)



Height at maturity:	60'-75'
Spread:	45'
Description:	Narrow crown, oval leaflets emerge late, changing from pinkish to a dark, almost blue-green.

REDMOND LINDEN (*T. euchlora* 'Redmond')



Height at maturity:	50'
Spread:	20'
Description:	Densely pyramidal habit; branches reddish color in winter. Large leaves.

RED OAK (*Quercus rubra*)



Height at maturity:	60' to 75'
Spread:	45'
Description:	Grows as much as two feet a year for 10 years. Leaves turn red in fall.

REGAL ELM

(Ulmus regalis)



Height at maturity:	50'
Spread:	25'
Description:	Fast-growing, oval shaped tree; leaves turn purplish-red in fall



WHITE OAK

(Quercus alba)



Height at maturity:	60'-100'
Spread:	50-90'
Description:	Broad, rounded form. Dark green leaves in summer, turning red in fall. Slow growth.
