

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEWS SOURCES

A strong community needs an informed citizenry. The Village utilizes six basic sources of public information so Village residents can keep informed of local government program services, code requirements, special events, emergency notification/instructions and shelter locations, public meetings/hearings and other new and information of importance. The six public information sources are:

- ◆ Carol Stream's Own- Local Cable Government Access **Channel #6**
- ◆ Newsletter- the **Carol Stream Correspondent** – a seasonal publication
- ◆ **Water Bill Message Center**- top portion of the monthly water/sewer bill.
- ◆ **Village Happenings**- bi-weekly community flyer - delivered to walk-up lobbies at the Park District, Public Library, Village Hall, local banks, apartment complexes as well as Outreach Community Center located at 345 S. President St.
- ◆ **4 Local Newspapers**- Daily Herald, Examiner, Carol Stream Press, Chicago Tribune.
