

PUBLIC LIBRARY

A general property tax is levied on behalf of the Library Board of Trustees to fund the operating expenses of the library. The Carol Stream Library Board is comprised of seven members elected to four-year terms. The Library is located at 616 Hiawatha Drive and has a 150,000-volume collection and a meeting room available for use by the community. The Carol Stream Library is a member of the DuPage Library System which allows residents access to books, magazines, and publications catalogued within the cooperative resource sharing system. Library cards are available at no charge to Village residents. Library hours are:

Monday- Thursday 9:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.
Friday- Saturday 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
Sunday 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. (September-May)
