Affordable Health Screenings Scheduled for Thu., October 5th @ the Simkus Center

Simkus Recreation Center located at 849 Lies Rd. will host a Life Line Screening for the Carol Stream community on Thursday, October 5th. Life Line screens the carotid (neck) arteries for risk of stroke, peripheral (leg) arteries for risk of heart disease, aortic vessel (stomach) for risk of an aneurysm and bone density for early detection of osteoporosis. These non-invasive, completely painless, ultrasound screenings take about 10 minutes each. Each of the 3 vascular tests is offered for \$ 45 while the bone-density screening costs \$ 35. Complete vascular screening (3 tests) for \$ 109, or all 4 tests for \$129. For information about available appointment times, call Life Line at 1-800-779-6353, as pre-registration is required!!
