Springtime Fire Hydrant Flushing Begins Monday, April 2nd

The Public Works Department will begin hydrant flushing on Monday, April 2nd and continue through Friday, April 13th. Crews flush hydrants once a year to remove fine particles, mainly iron oxide and other naturally occurring minerals that have settled at the bottom of mains during periods of low water demand. Because of the possibility of discolored water, residents are advised to run their tap in the morning to clear up any discoloration that may still exist. Absentee Voting by Mail—Absentee voting began Thurs., Mar. 8th and ballots must be mailed by Thurs., April 12th and postmarked no later than Mon., April 16th.
