60-Day Vehicle Registration Period Begins Tuesday, May 1st Through Saturday, June 30th

Beginning Tuesday, May 1st, Village residents must register their vehicle(s) with the Village during regular business hours (Mon. 7 a.m.-7 p.m. & Tue.-Fri. 7 a.m.-5 p.m.). Village residents must display a vehicle license sticker on the lower right corner of the front windshield of each of their motorized vehicles by Sunday, July 1st to avoid a 100% late fee charge that doubles the base sticker fee. **The Village Receptionist will be open on Saturday, May 5th from 10 am – 2 pm to process vehicle sticker registrations.** For questions, phone (630) 665-7050.

Deadline for College Scholarship Opportunity Nears

The DuPage County Department of Human Services has received a 2007 Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) for educational scholarship to eligible DuPage County students of high academic attainment (or potential) from a limited income family. Applicants must be income eligible, a DuPage County resident and currently enrolled or planning to attend an Illinois accredited higher education or occupational training institute. It is important to note that if an award causes a reduction in other assistance, the scholarship will be withdrawn. Interested students must apply by Friday, May 11th. Emergency Alert & Notification Registration Postcard is an Insert in the Spring Newsletter

Residents and businesses that have unregistered phone numbers can register for the Village's Automated Emergency Alert System through a mail back postcard inserted in the spring newsletter. This automated notification system links a geographic area with registered phone numbers and addresses for those same properties and then dials and delivers a pre-recorded phone message alerting that household or business. The CityWatch system can make up to 400 calls an hour and has a telefax feature to transmit alerts to businesses or homes that have registered their fax number with this service.
