60-Day Vehicle Registration Period Continues Through Saturday, June 30th

Village residents must register their vehicle(s) with the Village during regular business hours (Mon. 7 a.m.-7 p.m. & Tue.-Fri. 7 a.m.-5 p.m.) by Saturday, June 30th. Village residents must display a vehicle license sticker on the lower right corner of the front windshield of each of their motorized vehicles by Sunday, July 1st to avoid a 100% late fee charge that doubles the base sticker fee. **The Village Receptionist will be open every Saturday in May from 10 am - 2 pm to process vehicle sticker registrations.** For questions, phone (630) 665-7050.
