Acceptable wastes include solvents, fluorescent light ballasts & bulbs, fertilizers, pesticides, helium & freon cylinders, household batteries, auto fluids, thermometers, thermostats, mercury, acids, insecticides, asbestos, wood stain & varnish, oil-based paints, pool chemicals, poisons. Controlling for the Nuisance Floodwater Mosquito

To prevent your property from being a drought mosquito-breeding site, follow the precautions below.

1. **Get rid of old tires, tin cans, buckets, bottles** and all other water holding containers.
2. **Drain or fill-in any low places** (ruts and puddles) in your yard.
3. **Keep drains, ditches and culverts clear of trash and weeds** so water drains properly.
4. **Keep lids on your trash containers** to keep out rainwater.
5. **Repair leaky pipes and outside faucets.**
6. **Empty wading pools each week** and store them indoors when not in use.
7. **Make sure your swimming pool** is working properly and cared for while on vacation.
8. **Fill in hollowed out tree stumps** with sand or concrete.
9. **Change the water in** birdbaths, plant pots, and drip trays at least once a week.
10. **Cut your grass short** and trim your shrubbery to eliminate hiding places for mosquitoes.
11. **Store boats** covered or upside down and remove rainwater weekly.
