## Vehicle Sticker Enforcement Effort Continues

Vehicle sticker enforcement began Thursday, July 1<sup>st</sup> with \$100 ticket fines issued to those residents and business owners who have yet to register their motorized vehicle(s) with the Village. In addition, the purchase price of a vehicle sticker doubled on July 1<sup>st</sup> and beginning August 1<sup>st</sup>, an additional \$5 charge will be applied to the sticker purchases every month. ## Here's The Buzz on West Nile Virus Protection

Most mosquitoes bite at dusk or at night, but some kinds will bite during the day. Almost all mosquitoes will try to bite you if you enter an area where they are resting. To better protect you and your family, observe the following personal protection measures to help protect and minimize your exposure to West Nile Virus.

- Whenever possible, avoid places and times when mosquitoes bite (especially during dusk and dawn).
- Wear shoes, socks, and light-color, long-sleeved shirts and long pants when mosquitoes are most active.
- **Make sure door and window screens fit tightly**, and repair any holes.
- **Use mosquito netting** when sleeping outdoors and around small babies for protection at all times.
- **Use mosquito repellents with about 30% DEET** (about 10% DEET for children age 2-12). Adults should supervise repellent use on children. Do not use any repellents on children under 2 years of age.
